Both AFS and STI are committed to ensuring that all applicable legislation is incorporated into the safety program and to consistent compliance with that legislation. Every person employed by this company is responsible for maintaining the safety program and will be held accountable.

Managers, supervisors and employees are all responsible for taking the necessary action to address identified safety needs, communicating safety hazards, investigating hazardous conditions and accidents, providing training, supplying and/or wearing appropriate safety and personal protective equipment, and ensuring all equipment is properly maintained and meets legislated safety standards.

All AFS and STI employees and others on our company worksite are responsible for obeying all safety rules, following recommended safe work procedures, wearing and using personal protective equipment when required, participating in safety training programs and informing supervisors and each other of any unsafe work conditions. We recognize that all workers have the right to work in both a healthy and a safe environment. Everyone has the right and responsibility to refuse to do work when unsafe conditions exist.
